The AMPS is an ideal tool for the valid and reliable assessment of the quality of ADL performance and to demonstrate effectiveness of intervention.

Certification: 10 live AMPS observations after the course is required for rater calibration.

After the course, you are responsible to complete 10 live observations for rater calibration required for certification. Schedule: Please arrive at 8:00am on Monday, Nov 13th for registration. This may be a statutory holiday in lieu of Saturday, Nov 11th. Attendance from 8:30am - 5:30pm Monday to Friday, November 13-17th is required. Please note Wednesday is a longer day until 6 pm. There will be scheduled morning and afternoon breaks as well as a full hour for lunch.

Parking is available underground of the Hope Centre for a daily fee. We do not recommend street parking as it is limited to 2 hrs at a time. We recommend public transit (translink.ca). All Skytrains go to Waterfront Station. Take the Seabus to Lonsdale Quay then ride the bus #230 Upper Lonsdale or #229 Lynn Valley to Lonsdale and 13th Ave. Walk 2 blocks east to the Hope Centre at the corner of 13th Ave and St Andrews. The Academic Hub is accessible by elevator only to the 2nd Floor.
